

Training Options for Hamilton County, Ohio

CIT/MHRT– Feb. 27-March 2, 2012 Crisis Intervention Team Training Mental Health Response Team Training

Training Description: The 40-hour comprehensive training emphasizes mental health-related topics, crisis resolution skills and de-escalation training, and access to community-based services. The format of a 40-hour course consists of didactics/lectures, on-site visitation and exposure to several mental health facilities, intensive interaction with individuals with a mental illness, and scenario based de-escalation skill training. Experience has shown this is a minimum level of training hours. The materials covered are complex. The desired learning outcomes go beyond simple cognitive retention of the material. The outcome desired is the retention of behavioral changes learned as part of the training.

Training is **FREE** and supported by the Hamilton County Mental Health & Recovery Services Board, NAMI Ohio, and Mental Health America of Southwest Ohio.
